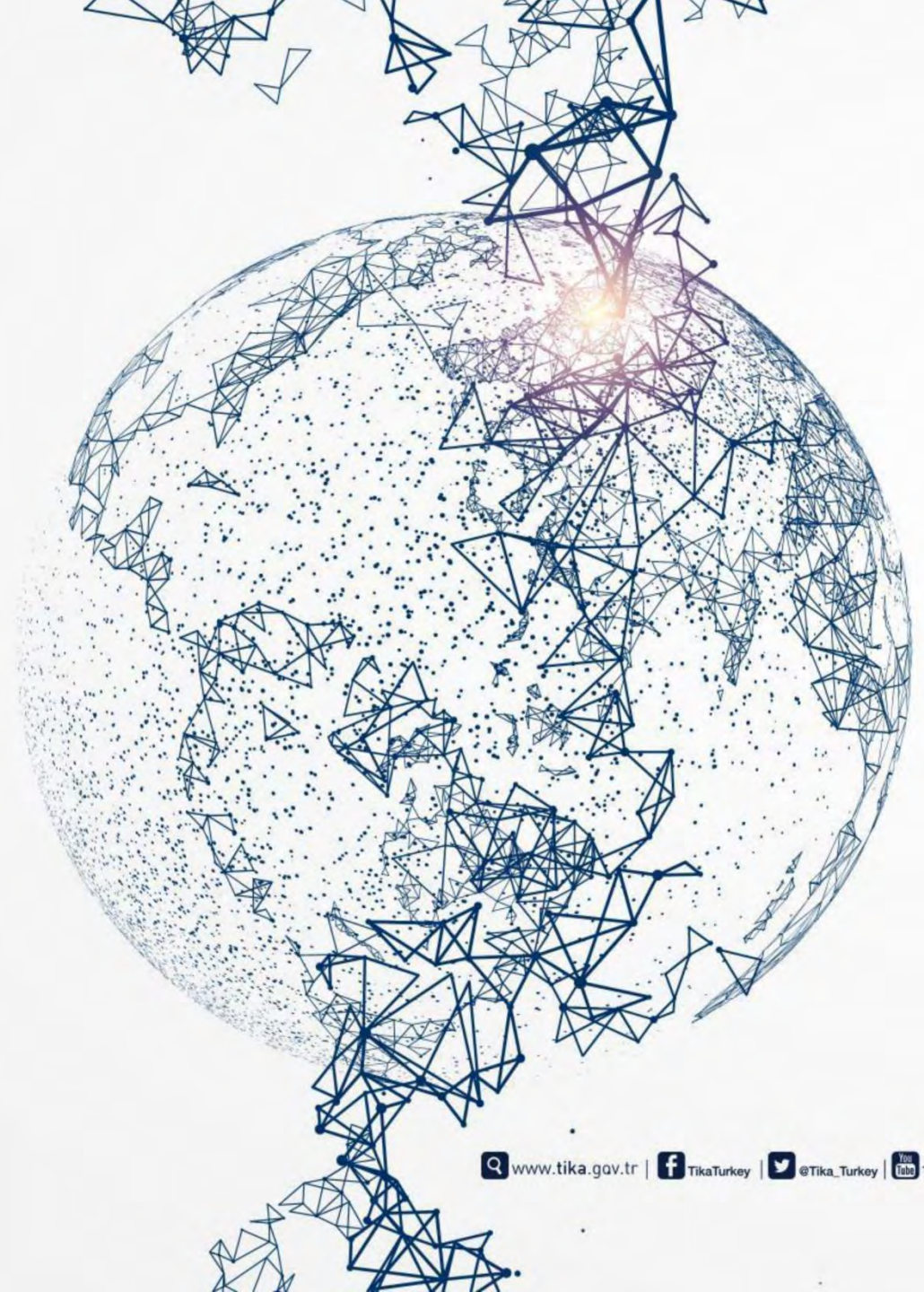

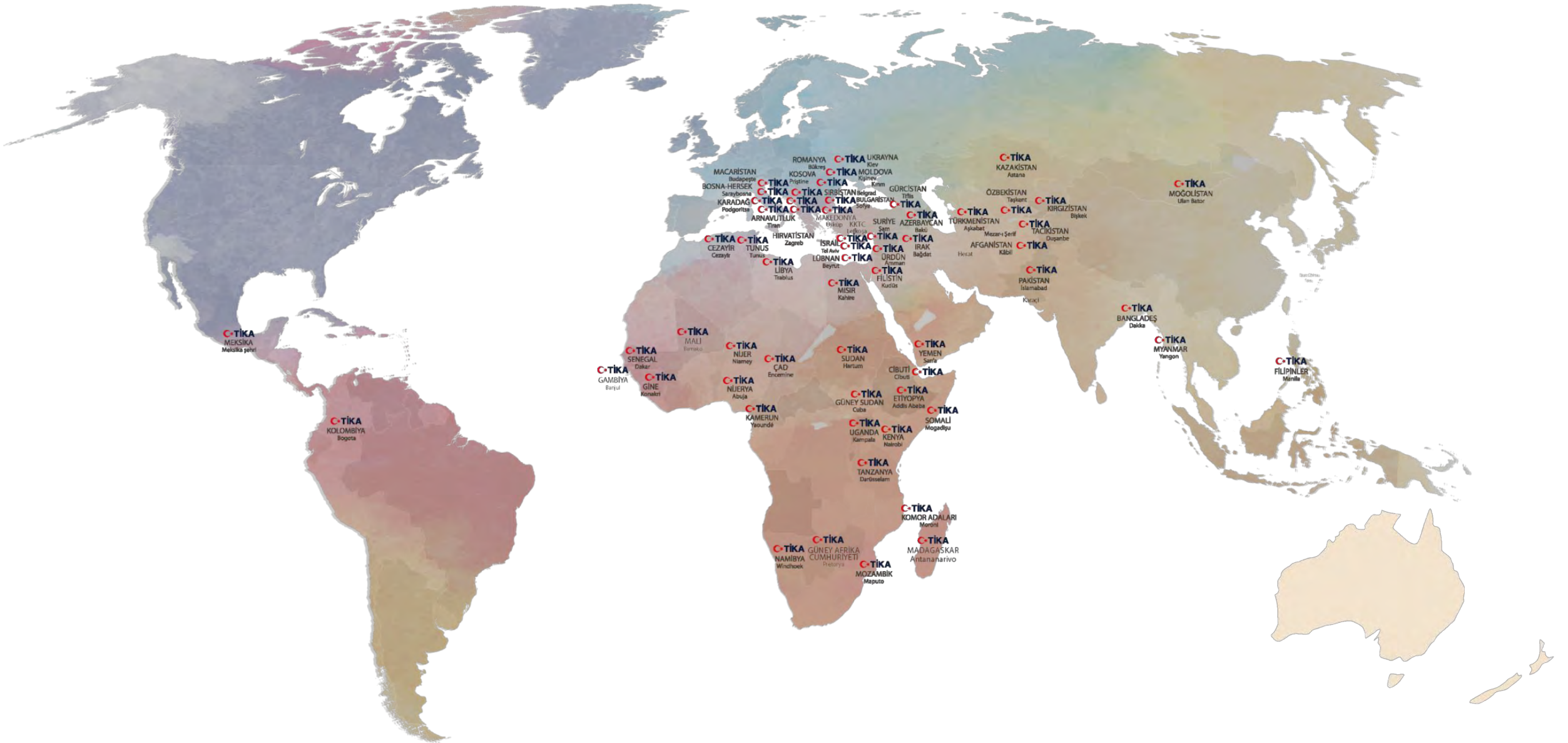

- While supporting economic, social and human development and cultural cooperation projects within the framework of international development cooperation, TIKA plans and implements its activities within the scope of certain strategies and principles.

- TİKA implements the Turkish-Style Development Cooperation Model in the international arena through people-oriented activities based on a sincere and transparent approach, considering the priorities and needs of countries, without expecting anything in return.
- The United Nations Agenda 2030 for Sustainable Development and the African Union Agenda 2063 are considered as basic parameters.

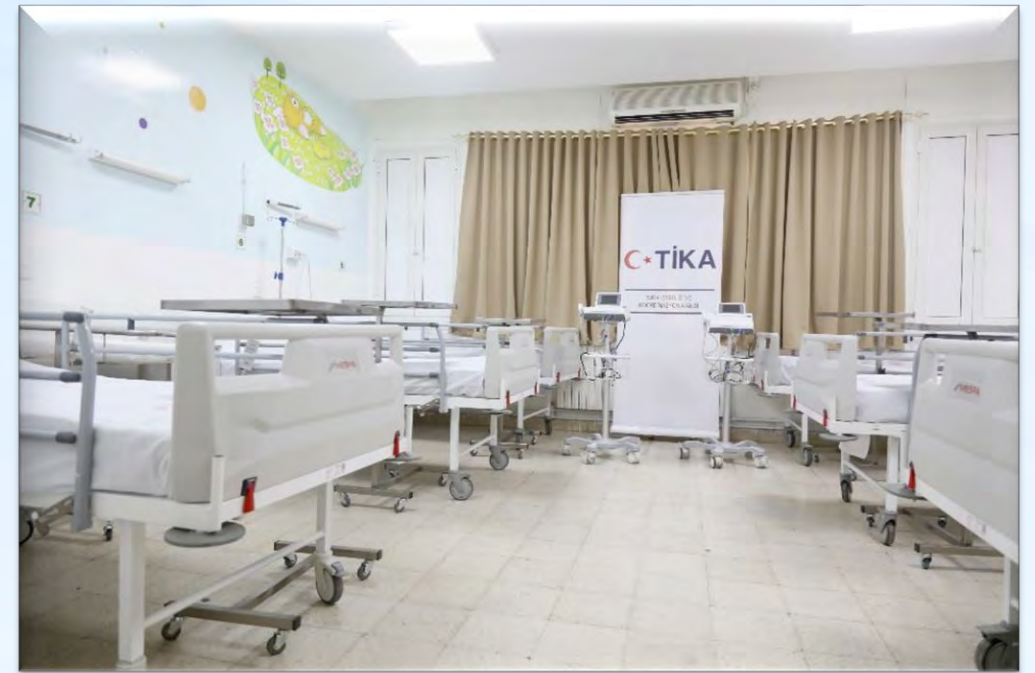
Niger - Türkiye Friendship Hospital (Niamey - 2019)

- Capacity: 44 beds
- Construction and equipment
- Birth: 200 babies/month
- +10.000 births



Tunisia Wassila Bourguiba Obstetrics and Gynecology Hospital (Tunis – 2024)

- Tunisia's first fully equipped maternity hospital
- Birth: 8,000 babies/year
- Examination: 20,000/year
- The patient care service



Niger - Türkiye Friendship School (Niamey - 2018)

- 40,000 m²
- 44 classrooms
- 1.200 students
- A dormitory with a capacity of 648 students



Somalia - Bondhere Orphan Girls Center Turkish Classes (Bondhere - 2024)

- Primary-middle-high school level
- 1,000 students
- Renovation + infrastructure development
- Equipment



Nigeria - Kano Capital School (Kano - 2024)

- One of the oldest educational institutions in Nigeria
- 600 students aged between 4-18
- The 6-classroom main building and computer block



Gambia - Support for Vocational Education (Kanilai - 2024)

Algeria - Lagvat Manuscripts Catalogue (Lagvat - 2024)

Ethiopia - Ottoman Consulate in Harar (Harar - 2019)

- 1912: Ottoman Consulate in Harar
- The Ottoman consulate was put into service as a cultural center under the roof of the Turkish Maarif Foundation in 2019.
- A large structure consisting of an administrative unit, a cultural center, a guesthouse, a cafeteria and a recreation area was added to the city's cultural life with the restoration

We Build Hospitals and Organize Specialization Training Programs for Medical Personnel

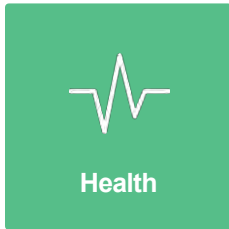


We continue to carry out projects and activities all around the world to provide access to health services, make specialized health services available, and improve human health, especially maternal and child health.

We build hospitals and primary health centers and renovate hundreds of them in numerous countries to make basic health services accessible to all.

Niger Health Organization

A 51-member Turkish medical team traveled to Niger to carry out a health initiative in collaboration with non-governmental organizations, aimed at improving the country's healthcare infrastructure. Over the course of two weeks, the team provided medical care to the Nigerien population. At the Tessaoua **Turkish Hospital, which houses the "TIKA Eye Clinic,"** cataract surgeries, surgical procedures, urology and gynecological surgeries were performed, along with outpatient services in internal medicine, urology, ear-nose-throat, gynecology, pediatrics, and general dentistry. **The number of outpatient consultations** in the fields of internal medicine, gynecology, ear-nose-throat, ophthalmology, and dentistry reached approximately **7,000**, while **1,214 surgeries** were carried out in the areas of general surgery, urology, ophthalmology, and gynecology. In total, **3,455 individuals** received dental treatments, and hundreds of individuals underwent laboratory tests as part of the health initiative.



Health Week in Chad's Baga-Sola Refugee Camps in Collaboration with UNHCR.

In collaboration with TİKA, the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), the Ministry of Health of Chad, and NGOs, Turkish and Chadian doctors conducted health screenings, cataract surgeries, and minor operations in refugee camps located in the Baga-Sola region of Chad. During the health week, cataract surgery was performed on **400 patients with advanced vision loss**. This initiative not only provided medical care to refugees who had limited access to healthcare but also facilitated an exchange of experience between Turkish and Chadian doctors.



Health



Empowerment of the Somali Albino Community.

A support project for individuals with albinism was implemented in Somalia with the aim of strengthening the roles of albino individuals in society, raising awareness about albinism, and changing the existing perceptions to help these individuals integrate more effectively into society. As part of this initiative, basic support items such as **health check-ups, eye exams, sunscreen, sunglasses, clothing, and medications** were provided to **35 individuals with albinism** in the **Banadir region**, and awareness-raising activities were carried out.



Health



We are Implementing Projects that Support Civil Society

We develop sustainable and multi-dimensional development projects for all disadvantaged groups, especially women, people with disabilities, and low-income individuals.



In 2024, we have implemented numerous projects in collaboration with over 250 different Civil Society Organizations, focused on supporting education, healthcare, culture, and scientific initiatives.



Ankara Culture Road Festival Colors of Africa Project

TİKA supported the "Colors of Africa" exhibition and performance at the Africa Culture House, as part of the Türkiye Culture Road Festival in 2024 organized by the Ministry of Culture and Tourism



Doctors Worldwide Türkiye Somalia Health Organization

In collaboration with our Presidency and **Doctors Worldwide Türkiye**, a health organization was conducted in Mogadishu, Somalia, from **January 23 to 31, 2025**, with a specialized delegation.

The initiative aimed to provide humanitarian and technical assistance, focusing on priority cases in the case lists, specifically in the field of Ear, Nose, and Throat (ENT).



Chad Health Organization

In cooperation with our Presidency and the Dost Eli Association, a **health organization was organized** in N'Djamena, the capital of **Chad**, from January **24** to February **1, 2025**.



The initiative aimed to conduct health screenings and perform minor surgical operations in the fields of Ear, Nose, and Throat (ENT), dentistry, and pediatric diseases.



Mozambique Health Organization

At the Ndlavela 100th Anniversary Maternity Clinic, which was rehabilitated and modernized by our Presidency a health organization was held in collaboration with Doctors Worldwide Türkiye from May 23 to June 1, 2024.



The initiative aimed to provide training to healthcare professionals at the Ndlavela 100th Anniversary Maternity Clinic and to offer curative healthcare services to patients in the region.



We Share the Experience of **Türkiye** through Vocational Training Projects

We support vocational training centers all around the world and share the experience of **Türkiye** with partner countries in various fields such as education, health, production, administrative management and civil government, and media.

We contribute to the training of thousands of specialists in collaboration with NGOs and public institutions and organizations.

In 2024, a total of 126 training projects were carried out, providing training to 4,910 individuals in diverse sectors.

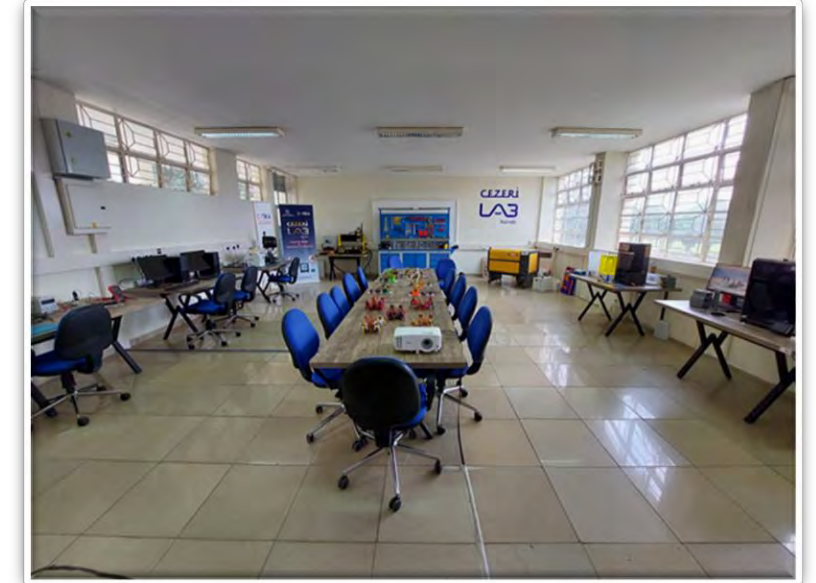


Kenya - Kenyatta University / Cezeri Lab Establishment Project.

Within the framework of the Science and Technology Education Program (BİTEP) carried out by TİKA, the establishment of the Cezeri Lab at Kenyatta University in Kenya has been completed.

In order to contribute to Kenya's sustainable development process in education, economic, social, and cultural aspects, many projects are being implemented by our Presidency in the region.

As part of this, the establishment of the Cezeri Laboratory at Kenyatta University has been completed, and various training programs for academics and researchers are also planned.



Tanzania Cezeri Studio Installation Project

As part of the **Science and Technology Education Program (BİTEP)**, digital production laboratories under the "**Cezeri Lab**" brand or smaller-scale "**Cezeri Studio**" setups are being established to contribute to the work of students and researchers at academic institutions, universities, and scientific research centers in the countries where the program is active.



Vocational
Training

In this context, **Cezeri Studios** have been established at the **Zanzibar Karume Institute of Science and Technology**, the **University of Dar es Salaam**, and **Sokoine University of Agriculture**.



South Africa – Women Entrepreneurs Training in South Africa in Partnership with MIKTA

In 2022, under Türkiye's chairmanship, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs proposed organizing a joint international development cooperation program in a third country as part of MIKTA (Mexico, Indonesia, South Korea, Türkiye, and Australia), an informal platform for consultation and coordination spanning multiple continents.



Vocational
Training

In this context, **the Young Businesswomen Empowerment Project (YBWEP) was implemented, providing entrepreneurship training to 20 South African women.**



Burkina Faso Disaster and Emergency Response Training (ADG+).

An Introduction to Disaster and Emergency Response Training (ADG+) was organized for **27 emergency medicine specialists, ambulance nurses, and emergency medical technicians** working at the Emergency Medical Services Directorate of the Ministry of Health in Burkina Faso.



We Support Agricultural Development



We hold training programs for specialists and implement application projects to enable the application of modern agricultural techniques by a qualified workforce and meet the agricultural needs of countries.

Thousands of specialists have attended the training programs held in the industries of agriculture, animal husbandry, forestry, and fishing; and, organized by the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry and **TİKA** in the last 10 years.

Somalia Development of Egg Poultry Farming

In the first phase of the Egg Poultry Farming Development Project, implemented in Somalia, which relies on egg imports, the construction of a 198 m² chicken coop was completed, along with the **procurement of 1,200 Atak-S chicks**, a local breed, and the provision of **training on modern egg production to 25 experts**.

In the second phase of the project, an incubator was established on a 155 m² area allocated by the project partner, Zamzam University.



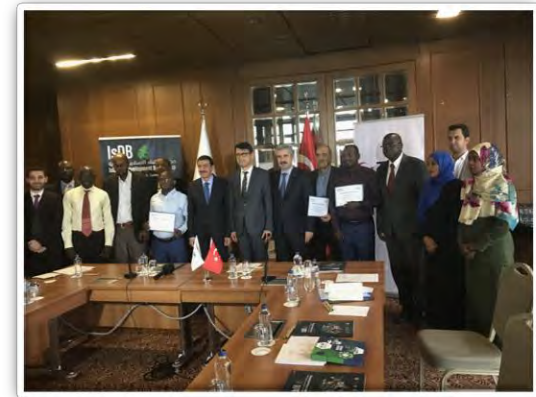
Establishment of the Somali Agricultural School

Started in 2012 by a collaboration between TİKA and IHH, “**Somali School of Agriculture**” Project was awarded as the **best Education project of year** in “**2017 Civil Society Awareness Awards**”. Hundreds of engineers graduated from the Faculty.



Greenhouse Farming and Modern Agricultural Techniques Training (Djibouti, Chad, Mauritania, Niger, Somalia, Sudan).

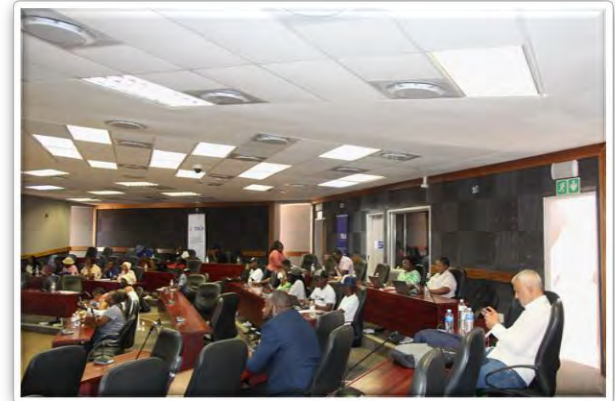
Specialized training courses and implementation projects are developed with a view to ensure that countries become self-sufficient in agricultural production and modern agricultural techniques are applied by skilled labor. In the last 9 years, thousands of experts benefited from the training programs implemented in the agricultural, forestry and fishing sectors with the cooperation of the TİKA and the Ministry of Food, Agriculture and Livestock



South Africa Basic Beekeeping Training.

A feasibility study was conducted for the establishment of a beekeeping department at Venda University in the Republic of South Africa.

This included an assessment of the **suitability of the infrastructure**, an **examination of the university's experimental fields**, and the **delivery of basic beekeeping training for academics**.



We support Women's Empowerment and Equality

We have implemented thousands of projects for the integration of women into social and economic life all around the world since we started operating in 1992.



We aim to meet the basic needs of women, strengthen their social status, and improve their economic situation through our projects.

We implement numerous projects for the integration of women into social and economic life through the vocational courses we hold to increase women's employment.



Republic of South Africa Traditional Beaded Jewelry Training

In the town of Steve Tshwete, with a population of 229,831 and situated 145 kilometers from the capital, Pretoria, a traditional jewelry training program was implemented in cooperation with the Ndzundza Mtshabi Traditional Administration.



Thirteen women received training in traditional jewelry making, and the necessary equipment was provided to ensure that they could continue their production following the training.



Pemba Island Blue Economy, Supporting Women Cooperatives in Seaweed Production Project (Tanzania)

As part of the Pemba Island Blue Economy, Supporting Women Cooperatives in Seaweed Production Project, **solar-powered drying greenhouses and grinding machines** have been provided to **24 cooperatives with 367 female members in the Kojani Region and 30 cooperatives with 397 female members in the Micheweni Region of Pemba Island.**

This initiative aims to make the seaweed processing process more environmentally friendly and sustainable.



As part of the International Police Training Projects, we are sharing Türkiye's experience in the field of security



Crime and international terrorism, which are among the major problems of the world today, pose a **serious threat to the peace and stability of nations**. Acts of terrorism and violence lead to the loss of thousands of lives and create devastating humanitarian crises.

TİKA implements projects in many countries to address these challenges.



VIP Protection Training / Uganda

Within the framework of the "**International Police Training Cooperation**" project, conducted in collaboration with our Presidency and the General Directorate of Security, a "**VIP Protection Training Course**" was held in Uganda from May 6 to May 10, 2024.



Training on Risk Analysis and Trends in Narcotic Crimes/Chad

Within the scope of the 'International Police Training Cooperation' project carried out in collaboration with our Presidency and the General Directorate of Security, a «Training Course on Risk Analysis and Trends in Narcotic Crimes» was organized in Türkiye for **11 experts from Chad**, from May 6-10, 2024."



International Organization / Summit Security Training / Ethiopia

Within the scope of the "International Police Training Cooperation" project, conducted in collaboration with our Presidency and the General Directorate of Security, an "**International Organization / Summit Security Training Course**" was organized in Ankara from March 18 to March 29, 2024.

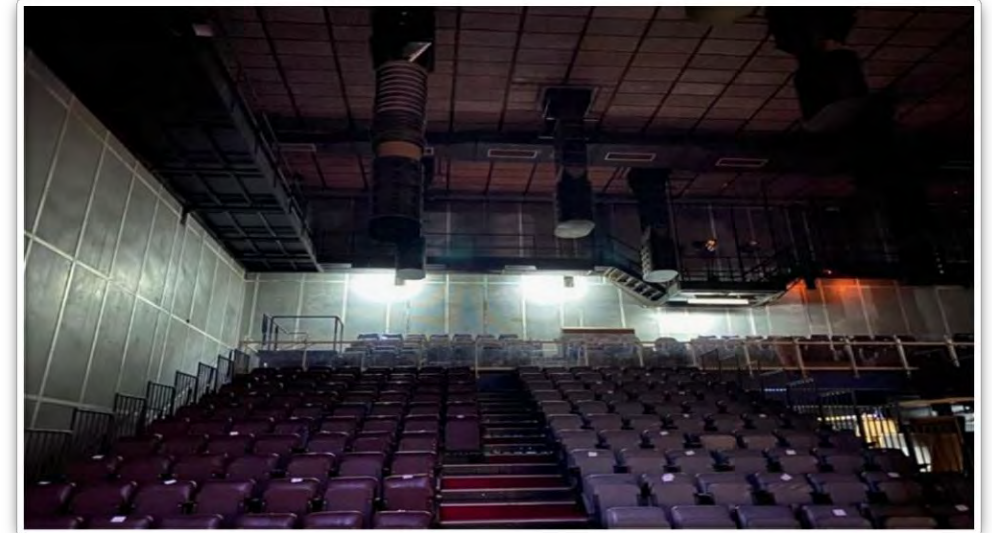
Establishment of a Television Studio within the Tunisian African News Agency (TAP)

An audiovisual studio has been established by TİKA to the Tunisian African News Agency (TAP), a public institution operating under the authority of the Prime Ministry of Tunisia, with the objective of advancing and diversifying news production.



The Capacity Building Project for Cameroon Radio and Television (CRTV)

Technical equipment has been provided to the Cameroon Radio and Television (CRTV) Institution to improve the quality of broadcasts to the public, and the existing studios have been renovated and modernized.



25th and 26th Term War Journalism Training

As part of the **Reporter Training Program** organized by our Presidency in collaboration with the Anadolu Agency News Academy, **two War Journalism Training** sessions were held in 2024.

The first group training took place from July 1 to July 12, 2024, and the second group training was conducted from September 23 to October 4, 2024.

Over 30 journalists from **Chad, Ethiopia, Mexico, Uganda, Palestine, Panama, Senegal, Jordan, Libya, Djibouti, Kenya, Lebanon, and Niger** participated in the training programs.



TİKA implements joint activities with other bilateral or multilateral organizations to achieve the global goals set by the international community.

Cooperation with UNHCR in Kenya Kakuma Refugee Camp



- A total of **238 major surgical operations** were carried out in the fields of general surgery, pediatric surgery, urology, and obstetrics and gynecology;
- **1,250 screenings and examinations** were conducted in internal medicine, cardiology, and obstetrics and gynecology; **2,500 screenings, 210 cataract surgeries,** and other eye surgeries were performed in the ophthalmology department;
- **500 pairs of myopic and astigmatic glasses were distributed** for the first time at the camp;
- **in the dental field, 1,500 screenings, 750 extractions and dental surgeries, and 200 dental fillings were carried out.**
- In total, **7,000 beneficiaries were successfully reached.**

Pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding signed in 2017 between TİKA, the General Directorate of Occupational Health and Safety (İSGGM), SESRIC, and the National Directorate of Occupational Health of Mauritania (ONMT), our Presidency has provided support in the form of equipment and consumables to the ONMT laboratory established in Nouakchott, Mauritania, for the purpose of enhancing occupational health and safety.
